## Kick Bass Organizer

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Write a four measure kick bass groove using beat maps.

## Kick Bass Writing

The kick bass should play on beat one and on three to five other times in each measure. Use $C_{2}$ to show note's attack and a line to show it's duration. To shift subdivisions, use the other subdivision grid in each measure. Altering the length of a bass note changes the sound of the groove. Adding one subdivision of separation between a bass release and an attack adds more punch to the second attack. Removing separations between bass attacks create a more connected sound. Each measure should have a similar rhythm; variation in the kick bass should be used sparingly.
